Last Month Minutes: Approved

Treasurer: Only 2 people are late for January dues. The fundraiser chair needs to contact the people who participate in the fundraisers and let them know what their credits are. The credit should be taken off the next month's fees.

There is \$11,000 in the savings and \$6,900 in the checking accounts. The plane tickets to Arizona for Slava and Kim have been paid for but the hotels will be paid after the event. The taxes have been filed and the franchise tax of \$25 will be paid soon. The 1099 forms have been completed for Slava and Kim for session fees paid to them.

Finance: Taxes were filed. A franchise fee of \$25.00 is due. All the meets have been paid for, the only expenses left are coaches fees and the state meet.

New: In the spring many terms of the board of directors and the officers are up and we need new people in those positions.

For those attending the Pink Invitational, please arrive early, they suggest one hour early, so the leos can be distributed and changed into before the sessions.

At the meets please follow proper etiquette for parents as in the team handbook you received when your daughter signed up for team. It is best to be courteous since you never know who is sitting next to you.

If you have any questions or comments either anonymous or signed, they can be put into the FSGAA mailbox and we will make sure it gets to the right person.

State Meet: The first thing that is needed are two people to shadow Maria Lash as Meet Director and Cheryl Santmyer as Meet Coordinator. They will teach you how to do these jobs and then next year you will take over the position. Don't worry, they will still be here for any help you might need.

We are hoping to only have 2 sessions, the first would be Levels 4 & 5 and the second Levels 6-10. Mid-Coast gym has compulsory levels and only four level 7, one level 8 with no 9's or 10's. So you will be required to work the session that your daughter is not competing and either set up or clean up. Sign ups for the different positions available will be posted on the team board by the front doors. We are looking to start the first session at 8:30 am.

We will be following the USAG rules that the top 3 get gold silver and bronze medals, but everyone will receive a medal or trophy.

Scott & Donna Pester will be taking over the food for the state meet. We will again be needing donations of baked goods and other items.

One more computer is needed to do the scoring. If anyone can donate their computer for the day it would be greatly appreciated.

Sponsors are needed for the state meet so please get out there and beg for some money! Also we are in need of bleachers again. The Glasgow Y will not lend them to us again, but if anyone belongs to the Kirkwood Y maybe you could borrow theirs.

T-shirts will not be given out at this meet. If you want a state meet shirt for your daughter, it must be pre-ordered.

Social: Woodward gymnastics camp information is out. 22 girls are signed up so far and the 10 & up cabin is full.

We are doing the end of season picnic at the U of D again this year with a treat of fireworks at the U of D following the picnic. It is tentatively set for June 20th 6-8:30pm.

Fundraising: Candy Brown is running the Joe Corbis. \$1.00 from all sales goes to the general fund. The total money you make is dependant on sales.
