Home Meet: Raised \$5,672.00. Consignment sales were low and sponsorships were also low. We will have a breakdown of food, candygrams, admission, and 50/50 later. We need to decide what to do with the money that was made by the meet. Should we buy bleachers, since we can no longer rent them from the Y, should it go towards our last assessment payment, or keep it as a buffer for next year? For next years meet, should we change the date since it is the same date as the Black Eyed Susan? Was attendance from other gyms due to it being the same date? The feedback we did receive was favorable. The coaches and judges that attended were happy with the way it ran.

State Meet: The state meet will be Sunday March 22 with 3 gyms attending for compulsory and 2 for optional. We are thinking there will only be a need for 3 sessions. Pre-team will do a demonstration of what they have learned this year. Having the state meet at our gym saves us entry fees, coaches travel fees and our travel fees. Cheryl Santmyer and Maria Lash will continue as director & co-ordinator for the state meet but are looking to have someone shadow them during the state meet to learn the position for next year. Any volunteers...?

If every team member brought in one \$50-\$75 sponsor for the state meet, we would be able to buy the bleachers needed for our home meets.

Social: Woodward gymnastics camp information is out and the best time to go is the week the gym is closed in the summer.
