Treasurer: Everything ok.

Finance: We should set a budget for the state meet and stick to it. No extra expenses. We are paying \$750 for rental of the gym; we are only receiving \$50 per gymnast from the 40 gymnasts from other gyms.

B.O.D.: Elections are coming up in May. The positions open are President, Social Chair, Secretary, and an At Large member. The position starts July 1st and runs for 2 years.

President: oversees the organization and makes sure everything concerning the meets is handled and makes sure the taxes are filed.

Social Chair: Is in charge of the end of the year team picnic and awards for all gymnasts and sets up get togethers throughout the year, for example the hayride or night at the movies...

Secretary: Takes notes at the general meetings and has them posted. Collects the FSGAA member agreements.

At Large: Fills in any gaps or takes up any slack. They have a vote on the board and can voice opinions.

New: Next year we will have a competitive Level 3 team.

State Meet: There will be only two sessions, Level 4 & 5 will compete first, and then the second session will be levels 6 – 10. Sign up sheets are on the bulletin board. You are required to work either the set up or clean up and one of the two sessions. Set up will begin at 3:00 pm Saturday.

SPONSORSHIPS ARE NEEDED!!!! We will not make much money off this meet since the majority of girls are from our gym and we have to rent the use of the gym. The only way to make a profit and reduce the fees for next year is for everyone to go and get sponsors.

The awards will go out ½ + 1 for events and all around everyone will receive a medal. The gift for the girls will be a drawstring silk backpack.

Michelle Dusseau will get together with everyone who signs up to be a timer to explain what to do. Scott Pester is taking care of the food. He is in need of a couple coffee pots, coolers and baked goods can be donated as well. Sign up sheets will be posted. Timi Murray will be in charge of the coaches and judges food. Cheryl Hughes is in charge of the admissions, 2 people will start off at the admissions table then one will become a floater. Melba Saxton is in charge of the money. Monet Wright will handle the floor music, and the DiFrancescos will handle the awards. To qualify for the state meet the compulsory girls have to score a 30 in the all around at one meet. The optionals have to score a 32 in the all around. Levels 4-7 just have states, level 8 also has regionals and levels 9 + 10 go also go to nationals.
