President/Meet Director: It has been decided the state meet for the 4, 5 and 6's will be one session consisting of approximately 63 girls. There will be two flights. There are 26 level 4's

The level fours will compete on vault mats for first two rotations, and then mats will be removed for 5 and 6 rotations. We will be bringing in 8 judges and running four events concurrently

We can fit 150 seats downstairs, estimate 3 adults per gymnast so about 250 people.

Set up on the 19th will have to wait until the U of De cheerleaders are done with their tryouts.

Time has been set for the meet, 8:30am open stretch, 8:50 March –in.

Set-up will be the night before after the U of De Cheerleader tryouts.

Things needed for the food area, hot dog cooker, donuts, bagels, fruit, drinks, soda and water. The food volunteers Jennifer Sadler and Melissa Liott will look into donations from stores as well. Kapila mentioned that Panera Bread throws away their extra breads at the end of the night, so we could look to them for donations.

Awards- Trophies must come from A1 vendor, Kim will take care of all the trophies. We need to order ribbons and medals. Medals will go out 50% + 1, everyone will receive a trophy. BJ Annand is ordering the medals/ribbons and offered to make an awards podium.
